## Online Log guidance Fridge Temperature Log



Fridge temperatures must be recorded once every day to continue to monitor the temperature of the medication/products inside the fridge(s). If fridge temperatures are outside of the threshold the integrity of the fridge contents is at risk of being compromised. You can access the fridge temperature online log on any computer, till or Samsung device in your pharmacy by select the Online Log App icon.

Access each of the fridge tabs in your pharmacy and get the minimum and maximum fridge temperatures and put your name in the 'Checked By' section. If the range of temperatures is outside 2°C – 8°C refer to the RP and follow the guidance of Breaches of Pharmacy Cold Chain in SOP 18/ Stock Management Resource Pack, ensure the door is closed properly and the fridge is not overstocked. Check the fridge temperatures again before the end of the day to ensure the temperatures are within the threshold and record on the fridge temperature log. Each fridge has a report which can be accessed by select 'Report' from here a 1 year log can be viewed and printed.
